

RECYCLING GUIDE

Annapolis Overlook has 100% **co-mingled recycling**, therefore, separating your recyclables is not necessary. You may place all recyclables (newspaper, cardboard, glass, metal & plastic) inside the dumpster **at the Recycling Center** across from the pool. **Please do not contaminate this dumpster with regular trash.**

| <p><u>ALL PAPER</u> – Magazines, telephone books, junk mail, envelopes, newspaper, flyers, brochures, books, catalogs, all kinds of paper such as that used for writing, typing, computers, copiers & printers, plus all other paper. All should be clean and dry.</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>NO</u> wet, waxed or soiled paper. • <u>NO</u> used paper towels or plates. • <u>NO</u> carbon paper |
| <p><u>CARDBOARD</u> – Flattened corrugated boxes, paper tubes, wrapping paper tubes, cereal boxes (without liners), file folders, poster board, etc.</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>NO</u> wet, soiled or waxed cardboard. • <u>NO</u> wax coated beverage containers. • <u>NO</u> styrofoam packing materials. |
| <p><u>GLASS</u> – Food, juice & soda glass jars and bottles (clear, brown, blue, red, yellow or green):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All should be emptied & rinsed. • Caps & lids should be discarded. | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>NO</u> caps, lids, light bulbs, drinking glasses or broken glass. • <u>NO</u> window glass, dishes or plates. • <u>NO</u> ceramics, glass vases or pottery. • <u>NO</u> mirrors. |
| <p><u>PLASTIC</u> - Plastic bottles used for soap, juice, milk, soft drinks, water, laundry detergent bottles & all bottles with a #1 (PET) or #2 (HDPE) on their bases:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Rinse all to remove residue. | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>NO</u> containers used for chemicals or auto products such as oil or antifreeze. • <u>NO</u> rubber products. • <u>NO</u> styrofoam cups or packing material. • <u>NO</u> plastic bags. • <u>NO</u> polyvinyl sheeting. • <u>NO</u> heat shrink-wrapping. • <u>NO</u> cottage cheese or yogurt containers. • <u>NO</u> plastic food trays (like salad or meat trays). |
| <p><u>METAL</u> - All food and beverage cans made of any metal (steel, tin or aluminum):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cans must be completely empty & rinsed. • Lids & labels may be left on. | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>NO</u> paint or aerosol cans. • <u>NO</u> aluminum foil or pie pans. • <u>NO</u> siding, scrap metal, fans, stoves or refrigerators. |
